What it means to be a Street Co-ordinator in Neighbourhood Watch:

The Aims of the North Aldridge Neighbourhood Watch Scheme are to work with the West Midlands Police Force to:

1. Reduce local opportunities for crime, thereby deterring criminals and vandals.
2. Establish a community spirit so that everyone can contribute towards the protection of their property by mutual co-operation and communication.
3. Advise the Police of any suspicious incidents or crime by telephoning 0845 113 5000 and asking for Walsall Help Desk or ringing 01922 439103 and asking for Kevin Pitt, Community Safety Bureau Officer.

As a Street Co-ordinator you are required to:

- ✓ Collect the annual subscription of £2.00 from the householders you are responsible for by the AGM, held in May each year, and pay them to your Zone Co-ordinator or direct to the Treasurer against a receipt for the subscriptions paid.
- ✓ Maintain a record of households who you are responsible for who have both paid and not paid their subscriptions.
- ✓ Deliver the NANW newsletters promptly, ensuring that your name and contact details are inserted on the front cover in the space provided, as Street Co-ordinator.
- ✓ Inform your zone co-ordinator of any suspicious activity that you may see even though the Police may have been informed.
- ✓ Pass on and receive information about Neighbourhood Watch issues, promptly, to and from Householders/Police/Committee as required.
- ✓ Promote neighbourliness by encouraging householders within your "Watch" to look after each other - see AIMS.

Additional responsibilities to Neighbourhood Watch are:

- To inform your household Insurance company when becoming a member of Neighbourhood. At present Insurance companies give discount to active up members. Likewise Insurance companies should also be advised if you leave Neighbourhood Watch.
