Your Mobile:

1. Always keep your mobile phone out of sight whenever possible
2. Mark your phone and battery with your post code and house number
3. Register your phone on the national database www.immobilise.com

Homes: Make sure your Mum and Dad:

4. Don't leave doors and windows open
5. Leave valuables on display
6. Leave your house in darkness when the family are out
7. Property mark the TV, Video and DVD etc

Cars: Make sure your Mum and Dad:

8. Don't leave the SAT NAV or holder on display in the car
9. Leave handbags and laptop computers on display when they leave the car
